A special repertoire requires a special approach in terms of singing and conducting. It is important for conductors and choir members to understand the basic techniques of a cappella singing, as well as the movements involved in conducting. Then they can translate their knowledge into productive, organized singing that elevates music to the level of truly meaningful worship.

The purpose of this workshop is to explore and enable effective techniques for rehearsing and singing the liturgy. Mark Bailey will teach and explain the art and skills involved in singing as an a'cappella choir. He will discuss, demonstrate, and facilitate participants' active participation through liturgical music designed for worship in today's Church.
