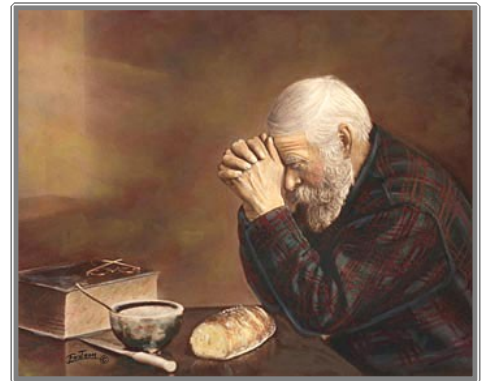


**2013 Clergy Conference:
