### **Course Description:**

This class is designed for singers and conductors who wish to (re)acquaint themselves with the concepts of conducting. Professor Drillock will introduce and practice the principal techniques of choral conducting and will discuss and demonstrate choral rehearsal skills. He will teach conducting mechanics, such as posture of the conductor, the conducting plane, the downbeat, the preparatory gestures, eye contact, meter, releases, cues, dynamics, and use of the left hand. He will also introduce and teach techniques specific to liturgical music, such as how to give pitches and how to sing hymns from text only.

# Map and Directions to St. Nicholas Church

## **From Saratoga and points north**

From the Northway take exit 8 and go left (east) approximately two miles. When you intersect with Route 9 make a right and cross over the Crescent Bridge. Make your first left onto Cohoes Crescent Road and continue on that road for approximately two miles into the city of Cohoes. At the intersection of Saratoga St and I-787 look to your right and you will see the blue domes of the church in front of you. Turn right to access parking.

From Stillwater, Mechanicville and Waterford take Route 32 till you cross into Cohoes. You will see the blue domes of the church ahead of you as you cross into Cohoes.

## **From Syracuse and points west of Albany**

Exit 24 from the NYS Thruway Follow I-90 East until you get to the exit for I-787 - Troy/Cohoes. Follow I-787 North to the end. It ends with an intersection at Saratoga St. The Church is visible on the left hand side right before the intersection. Turn left onto Saratoga Street and park either next to the Parish House or across the street from the Church.

## **From Boston and points east of Albany, NY**

Take the Mass Turnpike to exit B-1. Follow I-90 West until you cross over the Hudson River. You will take the first exit for Albany and bear right so that it will bring you onto I-787 to Troy. Follow I-787 North to the end into Cohoes. It ends with an intersection at Saratoga St. The Church is visible on the left hand side right before the intersection. Turn left onto Saratoga Street and park either next to the Parish House or across the street from the Church.

## **From Albany and other points south**

Follow I-787 North all the way to the end. You will see the Church on your left hand side. Turn left onto Saratoga Street. Parking is available both next to the parish house, and across the street from the Church building.
