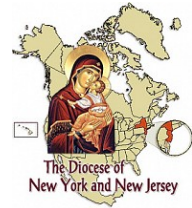




Liturgical Music Workshop Inspiring Children to Sing

Description: Nothing is more beautiful than the sound of children singing-at home, at school and at church. We invite parents, church school teachers, clergy, choir directors and others who may be interested in learning about how the child's singing voice develops from pre-school through the early teens. Songs and age-appropriate activities will be presented that will both inspire children to sing and help to develop their vocal and aural skills. The goal is for participants to feel comfortable making music with children and for our children to have confidence in their singing voices so that they will share their talents with others.

Dr. Mary Ellen Junda is a nationally recognized master teacher of children's voices, conductor, recording artist, and a specialist in the Kodály Concept of Music Education. With energy and style, Dr. Junda has presented sessions on children's vocal development and musical literacy for choir directors, music teachers, and classroom teachers across the United States. A professor of music at the University of Connecticut, Dr. Junda currently teaches a unique general education course focused on music and social justice, and conducts *UConntabile*, the choir for soprano and alto voices, and *Earthtones*, the world music choir. Dr. Junda is a member of Holy Trinity Orthodox Church in Willimantic, Connecticut.

DIRECTIONS TO HOLY APOSTLES CHURCH

From the north or south

Take the Garden State Parkway to exit 159 (Saddle Brook). Follow Rt 80 east to first exit- 62B (Saddle River Rd). Make a right at the stop sign and the Church will be on the right.

From the east

Take Rt 80 west to the exit for Garden State Parkway and Saddle Brook. Follow signs for Saddle Brook (not the parkway). Follow signs for Pehle Ave east. Make a right at the stop sign at the end of the exit ramp onto Pehle Ave. Take Pehle Ave to the end and at the light make a right onto Saddle River Rd. Cross the railroad tracks (under Rt 80) and make a right onto Platt Ave. The Church is on the right.

From the west

Take Rt 80 to exit 62B (Saddle River Rd). Make a right at the stop sign. Make a right onto Platt Ave and the Church is on the right.
