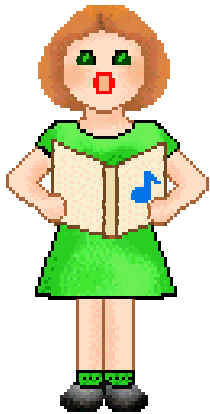

Workshop Description: This workshop is for choir directors, church school teachers, youth directors and parents who want to learn about teaching children to sing.

Nothing is more beautiful than the sound of children singing-at home, at school and at church. Participants in this workshop will learn about the child's singing voice and how it develops from pre-school through the early teens. Songs and age-appropriate activities will be presented that will both inspire children to sing and help to develop their vocal and aural skills. The goal is for participants to feel comfortable making music with children and for our children to have confidence in their singing voices so that they will share their talents with others.

Mary Ellen Junda is a nationally recognized master teacher of children's voices, conductor, recording artist, and a specialist in the Kodály Concept of Music Education. With energy and style, Dr. Junda has presented sessions on children's vocal development and musical literacy for choir directors, music teachers, and classroom teachers across the United States. A professor of music at the University of Connecticut, Dr. Junda currently teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in which focus on music literacy, general music techniques, choral methods and American folk songs.

Map and Directions to St. John the Baptist Church

From the north

Take the Garden State Parkway to exit 157 to Rt 46 west. Stay right on Rt. 46 over the Passaic River. Keep on Rt. 46. Sign will say Rt. 46 West Clifton. Exit at Exit 14. Sign will say Lexington Avenue. Stay right. This is Lexington Avenue. The Hot Grill is located on the right. Go straight on Lexington Avenue and at the fifth light, the church is on your left.

From the south

Garden State Parkway to exit 154 which puts you on Rt. 46 East. Rt. 46 East to Clifton. In Clifton, there are three lights on Rt. 46. Stay to the right. Immediately after the third light, exit on Piaget Avenue. Sign will say Piaget Avenue, Main Avenue and Botany Village. Go Straight until the fourth light and turn right. This is Lexington Avenue. Go straight and at the fourth light, the church is on the left.

From the east

Take Rt 46 west over the Passaic River into Clifton, staying right. Keep on Rt. 46. Sign will say Rt. 46 West Clifton. Exit at exit 14. Sign will say Lexington Avenue. Stay right. This is Lexington Avenue. The Hot Grill is located on the right. Go straight on Lexington Avenue and at the fifth light, the church is on your left.

From the west

Take Rt. 46 East to Clifton. In Clifton, there are three lights on Rt. 46. Stay to the right. Immediately after the third light, exit on Piaget Avenue. Sign will say Piaget Avenue, Main Avenue and Botany Village. Go Straight until the fourth light and turn right. This is Lexington Avenue. Go straight and at the fourth light, the church is on the left.
