<u>Course Description</u>: Singing liturgical music for Orthodox worship is unlike any other vocal or choral experience. Orthodox music is a special repertoire designed to draw the worshipping community into the very heart and meaning of liturgical prayer. A special repertoire requires a special approach in terms of liturgical understanding and vocal production. Certain techniques, therefore, aside from normal solo and choral singing, are necessary to elevate the music to the level of truly meaningful worship, and the purpose of this workshop is to explore and enable those techniques in rehearsal and during liturgy.

Throughout the workshop, Mark Bailey will teach and explain various unique and essential techniques to understanding and singing Orthodox liturgical music, and he will demonstrate those techniques by having participants sing through liturgical music designed for worship in today's Church.
