### Church Musician Appreciation Day

This was marked on Sunday, September 28th, the Sunday before the Feast of St. Romanos the Melodist. Parishes were requested to express appreciation to their musicians, and special petition(s) were offered.

### **The Order of Saint Romanos the Melodist**

His Grace, Bishop Michael, supported the Commission's proposal for establishing an Order of St. Romanos the Melodist to recognize extraordinary contributions of people in the field of liturgical music in the OCA. Originally proposed by the CoLM for the Diocese of NY and NJ, it became OCA-wide when the Synod of Bishops approved it at their Spring 2014 session. On September 27<sup>th</sup> four medals were awarded: to V. Rev. Sergei Glagolev, the V. Rev. Igor Soroka, Dr. David Drillock and Mr. Walter Shymansky. The Holy Synod determined that in the future, the award may be granted to one candidate annually.
