

Diocesan Youth Day on Broadway

WHAT: Aladdin

WHEN: Wednesday, August 22 10:30 AM – 7:00 PM; Show begins at 1:00 PM

WHO: Youth (children, teens, and college students) and their adult chaperones

This year the Diocesan Orthodox Youth Day will be held in New York City to see a Broadway show. On Wednesday August 22nd at the New Amsterdam Theatre the youth are scheduled to see a 1 PM showing of *Aladdin*, complete with a meet and greet with the cast. A meal will be provided in the city following the show.

Transportation will be available in and out of New York City. Following Morning Prayers with the Archbishop at 10:30 AM, a bus will pick up youth and their chaperones at 11 AM at Christ the Saviour Church (365 Paramus Road, Paramus, NJ). The bus will drop of participants at the same location at approximately 7 PM. We encourage those who live in New York City to take public transit.

At this time, we have reserved only 50 tickets for this event - they are on a first come, first served basis. Tickets will only be reserved when payment is received. Tickets are \$50 for youth and \$75 for adults. Ticket price covers admission to the play, bus transportation from NJ, and the meal following the play. Every youth under 18 years old needs a designated chaperone. An adult may chaperone more than one child. Only 15 tickets are available for adult chaperones. Once tickets are sold out a waiting list will be made.
