Dear Reverend Father and Parish Council,

His Eminence, Archbishop MICHAEL, in conjunction with the Diocesan Council, has scheduled the Annual Diocesan Assembly as a one-day event on Thursday, November 5, 2020, at Saints Peter and Paul Orthodox Church, 76 Whitehead Avenue, South River, New Jersey 08882.

In consultation with the Legal Committee of the Metropolitan Council and the General Counsel of the Orthodox Church in America, and according to our Diocesan By-Laws, the Diocese is required to convene the Annual Assembly. The Diocesan Council has reviewed various options for convening the Diocesan Assembly amidst the present pandemic conditions and has agreed on a one-day, in-person Assembly. Social distancing and sanitizing conditions will be maintained according to Diocesan directives. All persons present will be required to wear masks.

The Assembly will begin with the Moleben Service, celebrated by His Eminence and Deacon Stephan Karlgut. The schedule is as follows:

Registration – 10:00 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Moleben – 11:00 a.m. Box Lunch – Noon Assembly Begins – 1:00 p.m.

Pre-registration by mail is necessary. Please send in your Certification Form(s) and payment for Delegates and, if applicable, Observer(s), in time for the Diocesan Treasurer's Office to receive them by October 12. This is essential for the Diocesan Council to ensure that a quorum (54 voting members) can be achieved.

Credentials

Every parish is responsible for submitting a registration fee of \$75 to cover the Assembly expense. This is a reduction from the customary fee, because the Assembly will only be one day this year rather than two days as in recent years. The observer fee is \$25. Checks are payable to: The Diocese of New York and New Jersey. The Credential Forms for Delegates and Observers are enclosed with this letter. Completed Credential Forms and registration payments may be mailed to the Diocesan Treasurer's Office, P.O. Box 325, Lake Hiawatha NJ 07034. As stated above, registration fees and Delegate / Observer Credential Forms must be received by October 12.

In order for lay delegates to be seated at the Assembly, annual parish financial obligations must be current for the parish for the year 2020.

As per the Diocesan By-Laws, retired priests residing in the Diocese have a blessing to attend and be a consultative voice, but do not have the right to vote.

Observers

A member of the Diocese in good standing with the Archbishop and the parish, who has the approval of the parish priest, and who has registered according to the established procedures, has the right to attend the Assembly as a non-voting observer. Observers must register as per the instructions above, including a registration fee of \$25.
