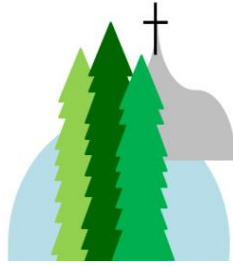

Counselor Positions: Male and female counselors (ages 18+) with varying skill sets, including but not limited to:

- Religious Education
- Sports

Counselor positions are for the entire duration of the camping program (4 weeks), plus one preparation week before the opening of camp, for a total of 5 weeks.
